SUBJECT: CON-13-128 Application of Carriageway Markings and Road Studs 2014–2017

### 1 PURPOSE

1.1 To inform Members of the steps taken to procure the above Infrastructure – Road Services Contract and provide details of the proposed work.

## 2 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 2.1 That Members note the decision of the Head of Infrastructure to award the contract for Application of Carriageway Markings and Road Studs to Central Traffic Management Limited, Unit 1D Bandeath Industrial Estate, Throsk, Stirling, FK7 7NP In accordance with the revised Scheme of Delegation (Appendix 2 to Standing Orders) section 1.11 Financial Limits and Section 4.6(f) of the Scheme of Delegation.
- 2.2 This report is submitted to the Members Library service in accordance with Standing Order 3.4 (a) and (c) for Members' information.

#### 3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The winning tender will be utilised by both East Lothian and Midlothian Council for the provision of Carriageway Markings and Road Studs over the next three financial years.
- 3.2 An advert was placed on Public Contracts Scotland on 6 March 2014 with a return date of 21 March 2014. Nine companies expressed interest in the advert. but only 6 submitted
- 3.3 In accordance with the Council's Corporate Procurement Policies and Procedures tenders were subsequently issued, with 6 returning tenders. These were then assessed to determine the most suitably experienced Contractor giving due regard to quality and price, The price element was

evaluated using a schedule of prices and predetermined model of quantities based on a typical annual works package, the quality element was pass or fail for contractors.

3.4 The evaluated tender results are as follows: -
