2. Matters Arising from the Minute of the Meeting of 18 November 2014

The Chair referred to the funding the Committee had awarded to the Musselburgh Riding of the Marches 2016 Ltd [£50,000 in 2014/15 and £50,000 in 2015/6] and reminded Members that a Musselburgh Common Good logo would need to be designed for use in all the correspondence and publicity material used by Riding of the Marches. He would circulate proposals for the design of the logo to Members in due course for approval.

3. Feedback from Organisations in Receipt of Grant Funding

The Chair advised that two letters had been received from Viridor Credits Environmental Company confirming that they would be supporting the replacement of heating in Northesk Church and Church Halls and that the project had been registered with ENTRUST. The Committee had agreed funding for this project at their November 2014 meeting.
