Spine routes giving access between the existing railway station and the expansion area, including the new local centre.

Spine route path collecting pedestrian movement from northwest Wallyford to new local centre overcoming the impermeable edges of the industrial estate and its access road.

Spine path giving access between existing and new housing to the new local centre, overcoming the impermeable edges of the industrial estate and its access road.

Masterplan to test alternative alignment to minimise harm to habitat value of woodland

Spine route path giving access between employment land, local mixed use area and housing expansion.

Impermeable edges of Wallyford Industrial Estate and its access road will require residents to north, west and southwest of Wallyford to be provided with new routes around the industrial estate to access facilities to be introduced.
