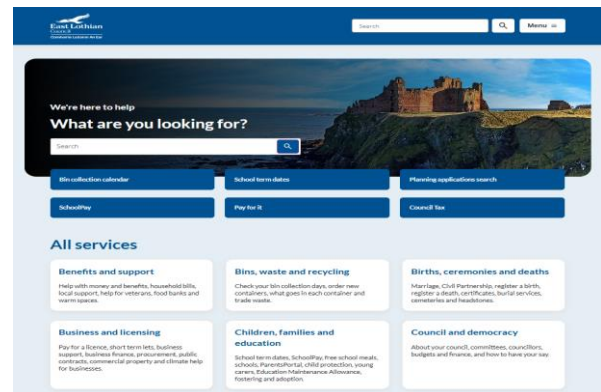

What has happened

- East Lothian Community Planning Partnership Board met on 26th May to finalise the review of its governance structure, updating the group's Terms of Reference.
- We are continuing work on our Improvement Plan with the steering group of the Participation and Engagement Strategy meeting to plan Impact Assessments in June.
- The process of developing the LOIP the was presented at the Scottish Community Planning Network with a particular focus on the approach to community engagement.
- Officers met with Scottish Fire and Rescue Service colleagues, to feed into their process to help inform the future of fire stations across East Lothian. This involved discussion around needs within East Lothian with our growing population and feedback from the LOIP engagement.
