A Discretionary Housing Payment (DHP) is a short term payment awarded to people who need help paying their rent. Any award made from the Discretionary fund should be viewed as short-term emergency assistance as the award will be made for a limited period of time or as a one off. Any ongoing award is intended to give you the opportunity to review your financial situation and/or find more affordable alternative accommodation.

In order to qualify you must receive Housing Benefit or Housing costs element of Universal Credit.

To be considered for a DHP you have to be paying towards your rent and show that your housing costs are causing you financial difficulty. We will always consider your individual circumstances.

The government gives the Local Authority a fixed sum for DHP payments. We cannot promise a payment will be made. Awards generally may be made on a short term basis but will take all of your family circumstances into account when we decide the length of your award.

Discretionary Housing Payment can also be paid to cover under occupancy (sometimes referred to as "bedroom tax") It cannot be awarded for charges due to heating, lighting, meals, laundry and other day-to-day expenses.

Please note; you may be asked to provide relevant proof such as proof of rent, Universal Credit award, bank accounts, proof of debts or medical evidence.

Sharing information with your landlord

Under the Data Protection Act 1998, we need your permission to discuss anything with your landlord. Sharing information with your landlord could help us deal with your claim quicker and reduce the risk of you falling behind with your rent.

We may need to check information, such as the date your tenancy started with your landlord before we can make a decision on your claim. We will only share information with your landlord if you have requested that we pay DHP direct to your landlord.

If you give us permission, we will be able to tell your landlord if:

- You have claimed or renew your claim for DHP
- We have made a decision on your claim; or
- We need more information before we can make a decision on your claim and what the information is.

We will not give your landlord any information about:

- Your personal or household circumstances; or
- Your financial circumstances

You can withdraw your permission at any time. If you want to give us permission to discuss your claim with your landlord, please sign below.
