## Fa'side Health and Wellbeing Profile

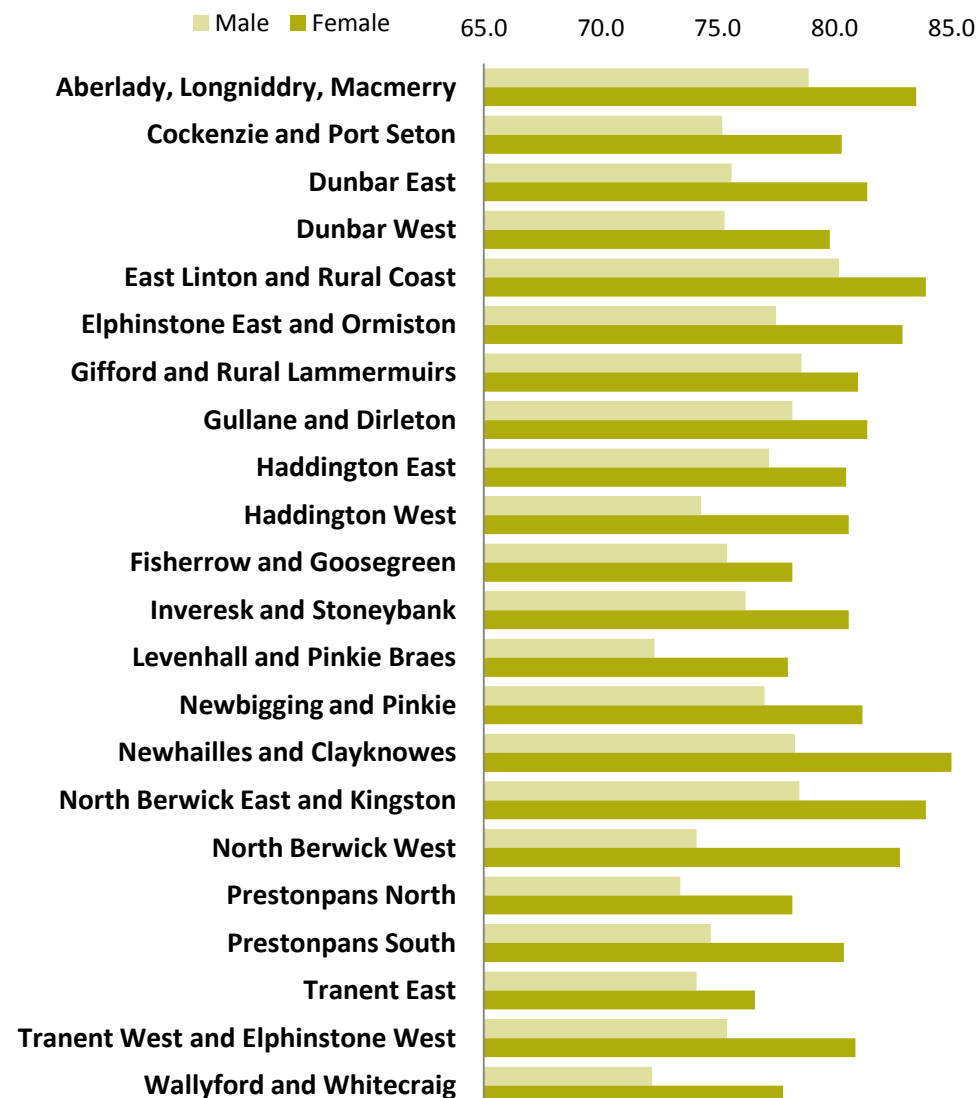
