

Key to using the Proposals Map

This proposals map forms part of the Local Development Plan 2018. It consists of a number of inset maps which must be read together to identify the relevant policy designations and proposals for any area within East Lothian.

Some of these inset maps have been produced at the East Lothian scale and identify policy designations that are best shown at that East Lothian wide scale. These include:
