

Affordable Housing in East Lothian

Affordable Housing to rent or buy

As well as developing homes for social rent, East Lothian Council and our Housing Association partners develop a range of other affordable housing.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR RENT

Mid-Market Rent (MMR)

- MMR properties are delivered by Housing Associations and some private developers.
- MMR homes are more expensive than Social Rent but cheaper than the Private Rented Sector.
- Monthly rent is set based on the local average local income and property prices.
- MMR is aimed at households who have a consistent income and have a local connection.
- The Housing Association or Developer is responsible for all repairs and maintenance of the property.
- Properties are advertised via Rightmove and www.eastlothian.gov.uk

AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR HOME OWNERSHIP

Shared Equity Homes

- Shared Equity Homes are delivered by Housing Associations
- The Scottish Government can provide up to 30% of the purchase price (which the home owner will be required to pay back if they sell the property).
- The home owner can increase the % of ownership over time, to cover 100% of the purchase price.
- The home owner is responsible for all repairs and maintenance.
- Properties are advertised via Rightmove and www.eastlothian.gov.uk

Shared Ownership Homes

- Shared Ownership Homes are delivered by Housing Associations
- Households will buy a share of 25%, 50% or 75% and will have the option to increase their share to 100% over time.

• The home owner will pay their monthly mortgage as well as an occupancy charge direct to the Housing Association.

- The home owner is responsible for all maintenance and repairs.
- Properties are advertised via Rightmove and www.eastlothian.gov.uk

Discounted Homes for Sale

• Discounted Homes for Sale are delivered by East Lothian Council.

• A discount between 20-40% of market value is agreed prior to advertising through East Lothian Council's Affordable Housing Policy.

• Discounted Homes for Sale are aimed at First Time Buyers with a local connection who can't afford market prices.

• The home owner will have full responsibility for maintenance and repairs.

• On selling the home, the % discount will be paid back to East Lothian Council which will be reinvested in affordable housing.

• Criteria is set by East Lothian Council and is available with an application form via www.eastlothian.gov.uk when properties become available.
