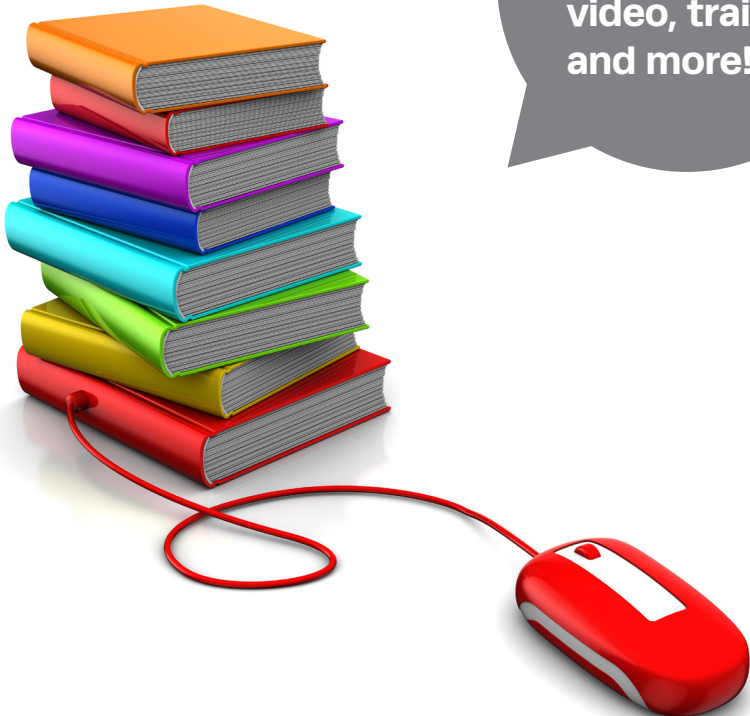

Each of our libraries has a warm and welcoming area for children and families with a range of books for all ages.

We run events such as **story times, book groups, Lego clubs, homework clubs, coding clubs, film clubs, crafts** and **author visits**.

Lennox, our library mascot, does try to get involved in our events so do keep an eye out for him.

Each summer we run a challenge to encourage children and young people to keep reading over the school holidays with incentives along the way and special prizes at the end.

Appiness apps, which are fun, educational apps are available on iPads in the children's area of Dunbar, Haddington, Musselburgh, North Berwick, Prestonpans and Tranent libraries.

Bookbug

Children are never too young to enjoy books and to encourage them we run the Bookbug Library Challenge. Each time your baby or pre-school child borrows a book they work towards collecting a selection of certificates celebrating their reading. Bookbug sessions are fantastic free story, song and rhyme sessions for babies, toddlers, pre-school children and their families. These run regularly in libraries across East Lothian. Ask at your local library for details.



As well as borrowing items, we also run a variety of events and clubs for adults within our libraries from craft clubs, book clubs, knitting clubs, writing clubs and more.

All local libraries are involved in the local community, hosting displays and exhibitions and taking part in events. We run and support Community groups such as Cancer Support groups, Dementia Support groups and various social groups. Please ask at your local library for details. Members can visit and borrow items from any of our branches.

Reservation requests

Reservation requests can be placed on items in any of our branches. These items will be delivered to your local library for you to pick up. There is a small fee for this service. If there is a item that you would like that we don't have in stock please feedback to your local library.

Inter-library loans

This service is a way of obtaining items which are not held by East Lothian Library Services. There is a charge for this service and only non-fiction, vocal scores and orchestral sets can be requested.

Book groups

We have numerous book groups meeting throughout East Lothian, which are a mix of library based groups and those that meet within private homes.

Contact your local library for more information about our book groups. If there isn't an existing book group in your area, why not consider starting one up.

Extra Support

Help using computers

All libraries offer free computing for beginners classes on demand, consisting of three x 2hr sessions. We also offer ad hoc support for customers, for example how to download e-books to basic skills for iPads. Staff also provide help with Blue badge online applications through pre-arranged appointments. We have a Computer Buddies Scheme available for those that would like to learn about computers. Buddies are members of the public who have volunteered to provide help to beginners in computing.

Boardmaker

We have *Boardmaker Picture Communication Software* available in Dunbar, Haddington, Musselburgh, North Berwick, Prestonpans, Tranent and Wallyford libraries. Boardmaker can be used with anyone who might need additional support with communication.

Hospitals & Homes Service

This service provides collections of materials to sheltered housing complexes, residential homes and hospitals for a longer loan period. Charges

Most library services are free of charge but there are fees for printing, photocopying, loans of DVDs, reservations and late return of books. Items not returned within a specified time will also be charged a replacement fee. Children under the age of 18, if still in full-time education, are not charged for requests or any late fees on any items other than DVDs. However, non-return of children's books will also result in replacement fees.

eMagazines & eNewsletters

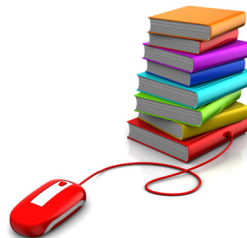
Press Reader is a digital newsstand which provides full digital replicas of current edition newspapers from 100 countries. Advanced features include language translation and text to voice. Content is always up to-date and often available before print editions. UK titles include The Scotsman, Daily Record and The Guardian as well as local papers; The Dundee Courier, Ayrshire Post and many others.

RBdigital Magazines provide free access to full colour digital magazines which can be read anytime, anywhere on your PC or mobile device. Read current and backlist titles of popular magazines with no holds, no check-out periods and no limits: keep magazines for as long as you like!

eResources

Ancestry Library Edition currently has over 4 billion records available to search. From historical census and parish records, to military records and passenger lists of ships which left Britain to start a new life overseas. Access is only available in East Lothian Libraries.

SCRAN: East Lothian Libraries have full subscription to this vast online collection of digital images and other material of historical and cultural significance. SCRAN is now available to download at home to your PC, tablet or smartphone.



eTraining

ArtistWorks for libraries offers world-class music lessons online: instrumental, voice and fine art classes, from basic courses to intermediate instruction to advanced lessons in art, acoustic guitar, piano and many more. Enjoy on-the-go learning!

Universal Class offers over 500 courses including yoga, digital photography, accounting and bookkeeping. With real instructors guiding the learning, video based lessons, graded lesson tests and certificates of achievement students can enjoy an engaging and measurable learning experience. Popular courses include *Autism 101* and *Confidence Building*.

The Great Courses

Library members can start their journey of lifelong learning taught by some of the world's top professors. With hundreds of videos on subjects ranging from photography to physics, astronomy to art, history to health and more. The Great Courses library collection has over 150 of the most popular full length courses with courses on how to do it, how to learn it or how it happened.

Transparent Language offers online language learning courses. Also included is English Language learning for over 25 native language speakers including Russian and Polish. First-time users need to create an account with their library membership number.

Theory Test Pro is a highly realistic online simulation of the UK's driving theory tests for all vehicle categories. It contains the official practice test question bank, hazard perception video clips and an online version of the Highway Code. All this material is licensed from the Driving Standards Agency (DSA), the people who set the tests. Access to Theory Test Pro is available FREE to all **over 16** East Lothian residents.
