- **Community Planning helps public agencies to work together with the community to plan and deliver better services**
- **Local Government Scotland Act 2003**
- **Community Empowerment Act 2015**



Purpose of Area Partnerships

Area Partnerships have been established as the local voice of community planning in East Lothian

- Area Partnerships strengthen links between communities, area-based services and **East Lothian Partnership**.
- They provide a way for local communities to contribute to the outcomes in the **East Lothian Plan** and influence service planning and delivery in their area.

- **Allocates resources and Area Partnership budgets to deliver the Area Plan**
- **It involves, engages and consults with the whole community and service providers to keep the Area Plan relevant.**
