Reprovision of Abbey and Eskgreen Care Homes & Belhaven and Edington Community Hospitals

Why are we doing this and what do we want?

- Responding to increases in the number of older people in east Lothian
- Shifting the balance of care from bed based to community based provision
- Provide care closer to home
- Support more independent living
- Raising standards of service, including facilities fit for modern care
- Respond to what people in East Lothian would like to see – engagement process

How will we transform these services ?

- We wish to Transform the way in which care is delivered
 Develop the potential of Housing with Care (Extra Care Housing) as an alternative to care home and hospital.
- Build on **support** already **in community**
 - packages of care
 - teams supporting people returning from hospital
 - care, rehabilitation, reablement support
- Respond to draft East Lothian Local Housing strategy
 - Develop 300 units of specialist accommodation for older people over a five-year period to 2023 (e.g. care homes, extra care housing or sheltered housing. Could be purpose built or remodelled from existing provision and developed by the public or private sector.

What is being proposed

- It is proposed that in Dunbar, North Berwick and Musselburgh there should be Housing with Care/extra care housing developments of 60 to 70 units.
- The specific proposals for the range of services currently provided are to transform the following:
 - NHS community beds to be reprovided in extra care housing
 - Day Treatments consider whether this should be provided in the East Lothian Community Hospital
 - Minor Injuries commission a clinically led review of this service
 - Nursing Home Care to be reprovided in extra care housing
 - **Residential Care** to be reprovided in extra care housing
 - **Residential Respite** to be reprovided in extra care housing

What is being proposed

- Since the Edington site also houses the North Berwick Medical Practice which is also not fit for purpose, plans for North Berwick will have to include the future location of the medical practice.
- If the strategy is agreed the IJB will ask NHS Lothian and East Lothian Council to set up projects to deliver new facilities.

What is Housing with Care (Extra Care Housing)?

(this is not an exhaustive list)

- Developments that comprise self-contained homes with design features and support services available to enable self- care and independent living
- 'Very sheltered housing', 'housing with care', 'retirement communities' or 'villages'
- Occupants may be owners, part owners or tenants
- Different forms from a development of single storey apartments or bungalows to flats or properties within a retirement village
- Different services including an emergency alarm service, personal care, nursing care, restaurants/dining rooms, domestic help, laundry, hairdressing etc.

Core ingredients of Housing with care

(this is not an exhaustive list)

- **Purpose-built,** or refurbishment of existing sheltered housing facilities, accessible building design that promotes independent living and supports people to age well in that setting
- Fully self-contained properties where occupants have their own front doors, and tenancies or leases which give them security of tenure and the right to control who enters their home
- Office for use by staff serving the facility and sometimes the wider community
- Some **communal spaces** and facilities
- Access to care and support services 24 hours a day (social care and NHS care)
- Community alarms and other **assistive technologies**
- Safety and security often built into the design with fob or personcontrolled entry
