## UNDER THE COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 2015

## NOTICE OF ASSET TRANSFER REQUEST

An asset transfer request has been made to **East Lothian Council** under Part 5 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

The request has been made by **The Ridge SCIO** and relates to land at Black Bull Close, to the rear of 72-80 High Street, Dunbar, including 5 buildings mostly in a ruinous/roofless condition and adjacent "Backlands" land.

The request is for **purchase** of the land.

The proposed use of the land is for restoration and regeneration of the site, and to provide a base for the work of The Ridge, including training opportunities, a support centre/crisis drop-in, admin base, workshops and social space for staff and volunteers.
