What support is available?

Tenancy Support is a free and confidential service designed to give new and existing East Lothian Council tenants support to help maintain their tenancy.

We can provide support in a number of ways and working together can agree on a way forward that meets your current and future needs.

The Tenancy Support service can support you with the following:

- **Maximise your income**
- **Budgeting**
- **Claiming benefits and grants**
- **Dealing with letters**
- **Access to other services**
- **Helping to find essential household items for your home**
- **Housing Options**
- **Help reporting repairs**
- **Helping develop independent living skills**
- **Settling into the community**
- **Improving the safety & security in your home**
- **Exploring training, employment and educational opportunities**

How can I receive Tenancy Support?

You, or a third party, (e.g. Rent Income Officer, Health Visitor etc.) should contact your Community Housing Officer at your local housing office for an informal chat about your circumstances. If you prefer you can make an appointment for a home visit (contact details are on the reverse of this leaflet). Any support we can offer will be discussed with you and your Tenancy Support Officer will draw up a Tenancy Support Agreement.

Tenancy Support Agreement

This is a document that will set out what you and your Tenancy Support Officer hope to achieve. Some outcomes can be achieved quickly, whilst others may take a bit longer, or even change, during the time you are working together.

What about confidentiality?

Your privacy is important to us so we will keep information about you confidential and secure, and we will only share information that you allow. When you sign your Tenancy Support Agreement you will also be asked to sign an Authorisation Mandate. This mandate will allow your Tenancy Support Officer to seek or provide information on your behalf. We process personal information in line with the General Data Protection Regulation.
