Process of applying for a breeding license

An application form requires to be submitted. This application is then sent to the Police and the Council's Environment Section.

On application and on renewal of application. The vet may also be asked to inspect with the local authority. Usually this would be an arranged inspection but dependent on complaints or intelligence received.
