## 1/ How many Syrian refugees has the authority offered to resettle since the beginning of 2014?

In October 2015, East Lothian Council (ELC) agreed to resettle 7 families per year for the 5 year period of the commitment from The UK Government. The first refugees (2 families) arrived in East Lothian in February 2016 as part of this process.

It was estimated in October 2015 that the 5 family commitment would be around 30 individual refugees per year.
