Q4 East Lothian Council (ELC) offsets new allocation allowance against arrears off for rent, council tax, housing benefit overpayment, re-charges and sundry accounts. Dependent on the levels of debt, the allowance may only be offset against one debt e.g.: rent arrears.

Some payments will go toward recharges, however, it would require each allowance to be looked at on a case by case basis to analyse further. Freedom of Information legislation only applies to information which is held or recorded by a public authority. A public authority is not required to create new information in order to comply with an information request. In view of this, under Section 17(1)(b) of the Act, I must formally advise you that ELC has been unable to comply with this part of your request as the information you require is not recorded.
