East Lothian Council (ELC) would qualify Q2a) as follows:

- The percentage is based on our Property Renewals Capital Budget which is approx. £900,000 per annum.
- In addition, the Property Renewals Budget is for all Public Buildings (including Primary Schools) which is approx £900,000 per annum.
- We have not included for works that have an indirect impact on accessibility. For example Fire Risk Works may include replacement of internal fire doors. Where this is the case fire doors would be designed and installed to ensure they are DDA compliant in terms of BS8300.

Qs 1b) and 2b) Secondary Schools:

Secondary schools are part of ELC's PPP Estate and are managed on our behalf by FES Ltd. We have made enquiries with FES Ltd, however, we have been advised that there is no information available for spending on DDA works on the PPP Estate. All Property maintenance expenditure for the Secondary School Estate is through the monthly unitary charge for the PPP Contract and is not split into separate categories of expenditure.

We do, however, have some details of secondary schools with adaptations that were not covered under the PPP agreement and were carried out to meet individual pupils accessibility needs. We can provide the spend, however, percentages are not held.
