## Clarification Requested:

In order for East Lothian Council to process your request efficiently, it would be most helpful if you could please provide the following clarification:

- When you ask for all overdue books, are you meaning from our Groups, such as Schools, Book Groups, Hospitals and Homes services and public borrowers or just public borrowers?
- Legally we can only ask for overdue items to be returned that fall within a five year period. Do you have a particular time scale in mind?

Please note that we can only state the fines once books have been returned, as they are overdue there are no fines as such.

## Clarification Received:

### Thanks for requesting clarification.

Just public borrowers would be fine. Many libraries have been able to provide all information going back many years so I would request that you provide all information you have (ie as far back as your records go).

I note what you say regarding fines. If you could provide your fine charging policy (ie £x per week, capped at £y) I can make these calculations myself.

Let me know if you require any further clarification.

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#### **RESPONSE:**

Regarding the fines we currently have an overdue fine of 15p per day on all items except DVDs with a hire charge. The maximum overdue fine for these items is £5.00 per item.

For DVDs with a hire charge we currently have an overdue fine of 35p per day. The maximum overdue fine for these items is £15.00 per item.

There are no overdue fines on children's books so long as borrowed on a junior membership. If borrowed on an adult membership the overdue fine of 15p per day on all items would apply. The maximum overdue fine for these items is £5.00 per item.
