I am writing to enquire about the number of taxi drivers who have been granted licences in the past year and how many have criminal convictions. I ask for access to information based on the following questions under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

1. How many taxi licences have been granted in the last 12 months?

2. How many licences were given to people with criminal convictions?

20

3. What are the convictions?

It may help to explain that there is a robust application process in place to determine the granting of taxi licences. For example, when an application is received, it is sent to Police Scotland for a report. If the report comes back from Police Scotland with an objection, the application must be referred to the Licensing Sub Committee. The Committee will then decide if the applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a licence. If there is nothing adverse, the licence will be granted.
