SCHOOL RETURNS

Ross High School

Approx 1 hour per student. 30 mins 1-1, with parents, the other 30 mins more ad hoc.

North Berwick High School

All pupils in S2 and S3 have a 10 minute individual interview with their guidance teacher to discuss subject choices for the following year. Further support is offered if this is required.

Musselburgh Grammar School

Offer 1:1 support through PSE classes with their Guidance teacher. From this session we will also have a parental and student interview with the Guidance teacher during the school day. We also have a parents evening and a separate pathways evening. It is impossible to put individual times against each student.

Preston Lodge High School

No specific time set aside, however the pupils are sufficiently supported in ensuring they have the information needed to make informed choices.

Knox Academy

No specific time set aside, however the pupils are sufficiently supported in ensuring they have the information needed to make informed choices.

Dunbar Grammar School

S2 =- No formal course choice

S3 course choice – 10 min Interview with parent/carer and Guidance/SMT

- Support as part of PSE lessons (not necessarily 1 to 1)
- Careers interviews available (30mins)

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
