WINDOW CLEANER'S LICENCE

GUIDANCE NOTES

Complete the application form and send to the Legal and Democratic Services, Licensing Team, John Muir House, Haddington, EH41 3HA.

- 1. The following is to be submitted with the completed application form:
 - a) The appropriate licence fee
 - b) Passport-size photograph
 - c) Copies of any, and all, Third Party Indemnity and Employer's Liability insurance policies held
- 2. In the case of a married woman, provide your maiden name.
- 3. The application should be submitted at least 6 weeks prior to the date from which you wish the licence to operate. It is an offence to operate as a Window Cleaner without a licence .
- 4. In terms of the Act, the Council, as the licensing authority, are required to pass a copy of the completed application form to the Chief Constable.
- 5. All persons acting as Window Cleaners require their own individual Window Cleaner's licence.
- 6. If the licensing authority has refused an application, the licensing authority cannot accept a further application for the grant of a window cleaner's licence within 1 year from the date of refusal, unless there has been a material change in circumstances. There will be no refund of the licence fee should the further application be refused on the basis of the applicant failing to demonstrate such a material change in circumstances.
- 7. The period of the licence is for 1 year.
- 8. The licence continues to be in force, if the application to renew is applied for, before the expiry date of the licence.
- 9. No late renewal applications will be accepted, and a grant of a licence would require to be applied for and granted, by the licensing authority before the applicant is allowed to trade.
