## WHAT IS A FOUNDATION APPRENTICESHIP?

Foundation Apprenticeships are industryrecognised qualifications that offer pupils the chance to study and learn as they work with local employers while still at school. They provide young people with early exposure to the world of work by undertaking an industry placement in their second year, where they can develop the skills, experience, and knowledge that they will need for their future.

#### WHAT LEVEL OF QUALIFICATION WILL I GAIN?

A Foundation Apprenticeship is an SCQF Level 6 qualification which is the equivalent to an SQA Higher. The key difference is that you will be learning through experience and you are assessed throughout the course, so there is no final exam. Foundation Apprenticeship students will gain an NPA award on their first year, and an SVQ award on their second year, making up the full Foundation Apprenticeship.





## WHERE CAN A FOUNDATION APPRENTICESHIP TAKE ME?

Foundation Apprenticeships build transferable skills and knowledge that can be applied to many different career paths and opportunities. Young people undertaking a Foundation Apprenticeship can:

- Enter directly into the job market due to the advantage provided by having a significant amount of work experience.
- Gain a competitive edge when applying for Modern Apprenticeships due to prior knowledge learnt.
- Gain an increased likelihood of gaining entry to college courses: many colleges accept direct entry onto courses for students with a Foundation Apprenticeship qualification.
- Gain an increased likelihood of gaining entry to university courses: some universities see Foundation Apprenticeships as two Highers, rather than one.
