Longniddry Community Centre was opened in June 1979 and major refurbishment was undertaken in July 2002 when a Library was added to the building providing much needed facilities for the people of Longniddry. The Community Centre aims to attract all ages from the local community and offers a diverse range of activities to suit all including babies and toddlers, several youth clubs, badminton, table tennis, gymnastics, fitness classes, continuing education classes, coffee mornings, craft groups, holiday clubs. The Centre is an ideal venue for meetings, for groups to meet, is available to hire for functions, or ideal just to drop in and have a coffee and a chat.

We have a Hearing Loop facility available in the Community Room and Quiet Room for those who are hearing impaired and the staff will be pleased to set this up if required. A defibrillator is located just outside the main entrance doors which can be accessed by the public 24/7 should the need arise. (Dial 999 quote the cabinet number located on the box and the operator will give the access code).

Youngsters are welcome to drop in during the day (not during school hours) or evening chat with their pals, watch TV or perhaps book a game of table tennis or a court for badminton or even an impromptu game of uni-hoc, basketball etc. Holiday clubs and workshops provide a safe and secure environment for youngsters during the school breaks.
