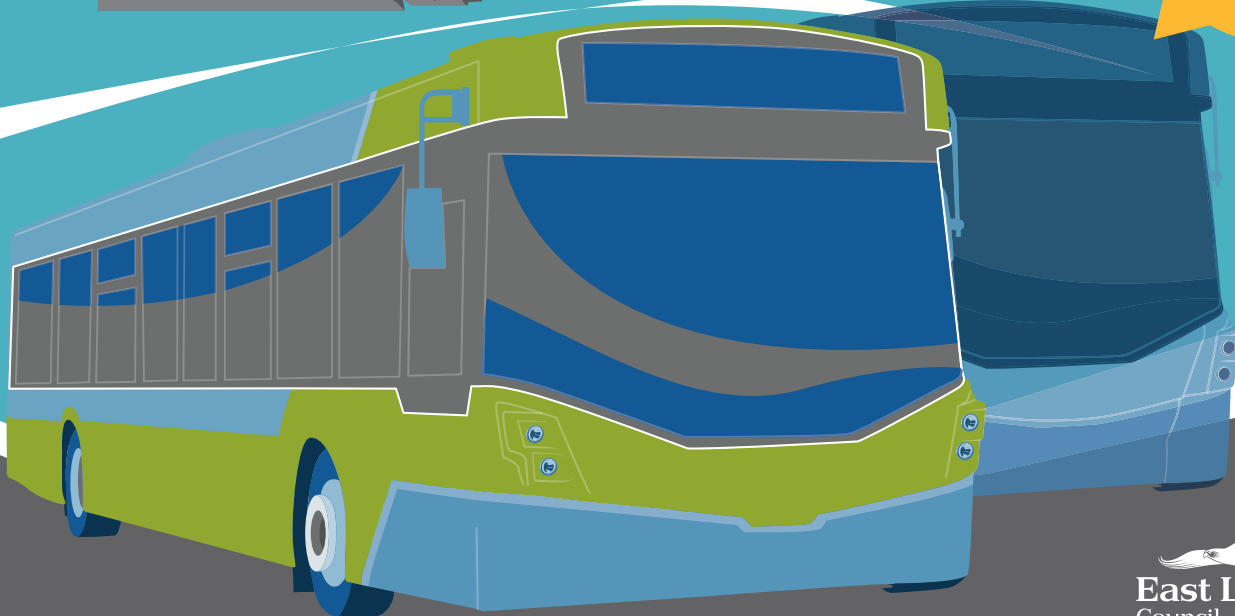

Contactless payment and journey planning apps make bus travel stress-free.

Bus lanes fast-track you through the traffic, offering quicker journeys and predictable arrival times, with no need to find or pay for parking.

Walking to and from the bus stop can also form part of your daily physical activity. Just 20 minutes a day can help improve your mood and significantly lower your risk of serious long-term health conditions.

And of course you'll be directly helping to tackle climate change: one bus can take up to 75 cars off the road, easing congestion and pollution.
