SUBJECT: Aberlady Primary School: Roll Capping for session 2010/2011

1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to ask the Committee to approve the roll capping of Aberlady Primary School for session 2010/2011.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 To formally roll cap the school to a maximum of **150** pupils in the school for session 2010/2011.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The school has the capacity to accommodate five classes and a transportable unit was installed to provide a sixth class.
- 3.2 The six class organisation at the school next session is likely to consist of two classes with 25 pupils and 4 composite classes with the capacity for 25 pupils making a total of 150 pupils.

4 POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 There are no policy implications in this report for the Council.
