- 1.1 To inform Members of the steps taken to procure the above Transportation – Road Network contract.

- 3.1 The East expansion joint to the above bridge is leaking water onto the abutment bearing shelf and requires remedial works to be undertaken.

- 3.3 Quotations were received from 3 Asphaltic Plug Joint Installers and ranged in price from £11,726.11 to £17,340.00.
