## **1 PURPOSE**

- 1.1 To advise on financial assistance to be awarded through the Sports Award Scheme to talented sportsmen and women competing and training outwith the UK and to teams who have competed successfully in national events qualifying them for additional competition either within or outwith the UK.

## **3 BACKGROUND**

- 3.1 Bartosz Andrzejewski was selected by JKA Karate-Do Shotokan, Scotland to compete in the JKA European Championships in Konstanz, Germany on 20 April 2013.
- 3.2 Ross Muir is one of only two players selected by Scottish Snooker to take part in the 2013 European Snooker Championships in Zielona Gora, Poland from 27 May – 6 June 2013.
- 3.3 Saltire Team Gymnastics, based at Meadowmill Sports Centre, has a membership of almost 200 and is now one of the leading gymnastics clubs in Scotland. Two of their teams – Junior National Girls and Primary Boys – have qualified to take part in the 2013 British Championships in Stoke on Trent from 24-26 May. As the only two Scottish teams to qualify it is a great achievement for the club but there will be considerable

additional expense to the club as a result of their participation in this event.
