1 PURPOSE

1.1 To advise on financial assistance to be awarded through the Sports Award Scheme to talented sportsmen and women competing and training out with the UK and to teams who have competed successfully in national events qualifying them for additional competition either within or out with the UK.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Brodie Mackay has been selected for the International Belgian Karate Kumite Open between 15th and 18th November. The competition will give Brodie valuable experience at International level and work towards national squad selection.
- 3.2 Snooker player Ross Muir has was selected for the Asian Tour Tournament ATZ in China. The award will make a contribution towards the £1800 total cost of the travel and accommodation.
- 3.3 Mary Anderson will represent Great Britain at the DFAC World Bodybuilding Championships in Florida in November. The award will make a contribution towards the cost of the trip which is circa £1,100.
