## **1 PURPOSE**

- 1.1 To note the dismissal of a single, remaining objection to the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order to prohibit waiting, loading and unloading, in Victoria Park, Haddington.

## **3 BACKGROUND**

- 3.1 Following approval of the Cabinet report, Item 6, Cabinet, 14 May 2013 the statutory procedures were commenced. During the consultation period (9<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> August 2013) two letters were received, only one of which was considered to be an objection.
- 3.2 However, the objection has been dismissed on the grounds as that it relates primarily to the granting approval of the related planning application. The granting of planning permission is a matter for the planning authority and therefore the objection is not pertinent to the introduction of the Traffic Regulation Order.

## **4 POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

- 4.1 The introduction of waiting loading and unloading restrictions will contribute to Growing our Communities – East Lothian's homes and roads are safer.
