1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 To advise on financial assistance to be awarded through the Sports Award Scheme to talented sportsmen and women competing and training outwith the UK and to teams who have competed successfully in national events qualifying them for additional competition either within or outwith the UK.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Both Gavin and Brad Robertson are due to compete in the World Tae Kwon Do Championships in Rome between 23rd and 27th July 2014. They are both representing Scotland at the championships with Brad qualifying in 1st place from the seeding process. Callum Smith is due to compete in the European Championships in Ireland between 26th and 30th June.
- 3.2 Ross and Murdo Lunn will both compete in the JKA European Junior Championships in Prague, Czech Republic on 24th and 25th May 2014.

Murdo Lunn was also selected to represent Scotland at the JKA European Senior Championships on 5th April 2014 in Kortrijk, Belgium.
