1 PURPOSE

1.1 To record the award of places on a framework agreement for the Provision of Extensions and Alterations to Council Houses.

2 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 2.1 Members are requested to note the decision of the Head of Development in consultation with the Head of Council Resources to accept the following 5Nr contractors into a framework agreement, for a period of two years, with one optional extension of one year, from 15th May 2014:
 - Campbell & Smith, Ormiston
 - Gordon Guthrie, Edinburgh
 - Ashwood Scotland, Bathgate
 - SR Joinery, Ormiston
 - Individually Designed Homes, Musselburgh

3 BACKGROUND

3.1 This contract opportunity was advertised in the national portal <u>www.publiccontractsscotland.gov.uk</u> in November 2013, and tenders were returned in December 2013.

Prior to formal advertisement of the tender opportunity, advance notice of this, and other tender opportunities was advertised in the local press, inviting expressions of interest from contractors. Following this, the Council facilitated a number of workshops to provide information to interested contractors and to offer advice and tuition designed to help contractors understand the tendering process through the national portal.

Allowing this opportunity for Contractors has resulted in the appointment to the Framework of two Contractors who have had no previous experience of working with the Council.

4 COMPARISON OF TENDERS

4.1 5Nr contractors submitted tenders. These bids were evaluated for Quality through an initial two stage "Selection" process which allocated scores for 1) Health & Safety 2) Equal Opportunities 3) Evidence of Experience, and all 5Nr Contractors progressed to the third and final "Award" stage.

The final criteria and weightings were as follows:

4.2 The Council's original intention was to have 6Nr contractors on the framework, however as only 5Nr tenders were received, and no contractor scored below the threshold required to progress through the assessment process, all 5Nr contractors were recommended to be placed on the Framework. The final scores were as follows:

4.3 Notifications to the successful contractors were sent on 1st May 2014 by email.

4.4 Competitive tenders will be sought from all 5Nr Contractors on the framework, and works will be awarded to the lowest priced Contractor in each case.
