### 1 PURPOSE

1.1 To advise Members of a reciprocal visit from the City of Pardubice, Czech Republic from Thursday 4th September – Sunday 8th September 2014.

#### 2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 That Members note and approve the above visit.

#### 3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 A relationship between East Lothian and Pardubice (twinned with Rosignano Marittimo, Musselburgh's twin town) was established during previous 3-way visits and was further developed in June 2006. Since then, the link has continued to develop with a number of visits from both sides including teacher and cultural exchanges and local government official study visits.
- 3.2 In April 2013, a group of runners were invited from East Lothian to participate in the Pardubice Winery Half Marathon which takes place annually. Five runners were selected from each of the local running clubs and the cost of hosting the group was met by the Municipality of Pardubice.
- 3.3 As a result of this successful visit, a reciprocal invitation was extended to a group of runners from Pardubice to participate in the Scottish Half Marathon on 6 September as part of this year's Homecoming 2014 celebrations. Six runners have confirmed their participation in the event and will be accompanied by Tomas Cabrnoh a member of the Municipality's External Relations Department.

- 3.4 The Scottish Marathon organisers have offered the group complimentary spaces into the event. East Lothian Council will market the event through press releases in the local papers.
- 3.5 In addition to participating in the marathon, a programme has been devised to include visits to some of East Lothian's visitor attractions and attendance at social events organised by the local running clubs. There will also be an opportunity to meet with elected members and senior officials to open discussions to any new potential projects.
