1. Appointment of a Chair

Councillor Veitch proposed that Councillor Hampshire accept the role of Chair and Councillor Hampshire agreed.

In response to a question from the Chair, Mrs Maciver confirmed that the Committee had an additional balance of £4000 available to award between now and the end of the financial year. The Committee agreed that, after taking account of the cost of the annual local fireworks, the remaining sum should be shared between as many groups as possible. The Committee agreed that individual awards might be limited to £500, dependent on the number of applications received.

2a. Application for Assistance – Dunbar Shore and Harbour Neighbourhood Group

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Dunbar Shore and Neighbourhood Group for funding of £4082.43 to create a sculpture in Victoria Street, Dunbar.

Decision

The Common Good Committee agreed unanimously to grant the application in part and provide the sum of £500.

2b. Application for Assistance – Dunbar and District History Society

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Dunbar and District History Society for funding of £477.70 to purchase an 'Avanti' picture hanging system for Dunbar Town House Museum and Gallery.

Decision

The Common Good Committee agreed unanimously to grant the application in part and provide the sum of £400.
