1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 To advise on financial assistance to be awarded through the Sports Award Scheme to talented sportsmen and women competing and training outwith the UK and to teams who have competed successfully in national events qualifying them for additional competition either within or outwith the UK.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Based at Meadowmill Sports Centre, City of Edinburgh Trampoline Club have had a coach (Lauren Jeffrey) and an athlete (Caitlin O'Brien) selected for the World Championships in Daytona. The event is self funded and there are also a number of preparation camps the coach and athlete have to attend at the National Gymnastics Centre at Lilleshall, Shropshire.
- 3.2 Morgan Cunningham has competed in 3 different European based competitions to support her progress as an elite Karate athlete. The competitions were the Budo Nord Dublin Open in May, the Banzai Cup in Berlin in September and the Gothenburg Kumite Open in October. All competitions give Morgan experience at international level.
