1. Appointment of the Chair

2. Applications for Consideration

a. Application for Assistance – The Peter Potter Gallery Trust

The Common Good Committee considered an application by The Peter Potter Gallery Trust for funding to support their arts education programme.

Decision

The Common Good Committee agreed to reject the application for funding on the grounds that the Trust was not legally constituted at the time the application was submitted. The Committee suggested that the Trust submit a new application, as a new organisation, at a future date.

b. Application for Assistance – The Royal Burgh of Haddington and District Community Council

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Haddington Community Council for funding to build a skate park for the youngsters of Haddington and the wider community.

Decision

The Common Good Committee was minded to support the application in part and provide the sum of £5000. However, it indicated that any offer of funding would be subject to the Community Council providing additional information on the project and securing financial support from other sources.
