Area during the Academic Year 2015/16

1 PURPOSE

1.1 To inform members of the recent amendment, under delegated powers, of the number of reserve places at Innerwick Primary School for academic year 2015/16.

- 3.1 On 7 April 2015 the Education Committee agreed a number of reserve places in schools for catchment pupils who move into the catchment area during the academic year 2015/16.
- 3.2 The Committee also agreed to delegate any changes to the number of places held in reserve to the Head of Education in consultation with the Convener, should the number of pupils requiring a place at the school significantly change.
