1 PURPOSE

1.1 To advise support of The Patron's Lunch, at local level, to celebrate HM the Queen's 90th birthday in June 2016. www.thepatronslunch.com

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 That Members note the allocation of funds to be made through delegated powers by the Head of Communities and Partnerships.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 At Joint Senior Members & Officers Group in September 2015 it was agreed to support The Patron's Lunch initiative through the Local Area Partnerships.
- 3.2 HM the Queen's 90th birthday will be marked with a weekend long celebration beginning with a National Service of Thanksgiving at St Pauls Cathedral on Friday 10 June, followed by Trooping the Colour on Saturday 11 June and culminating in the Patron's Lunch on Sunday 12 June.
- 3.3 The Patron's Lunch will comprise of a street party on The Mall to honour Her Majesty's patronage of over 600 organisations. Representatives of these organisations will be invited and further tickets will be available for a public ballot. The event has three core themes – charity, celebration and community.
- 3.4 A request was received seeking the support of local communities to hold their own celebrations.

3.5 It has been agreed that East Lothian Council provide a fund to assist local groups mark the occasion. A budget of £1,000 will be given to each Local Area Partnership to distribute appropriately within their area.
