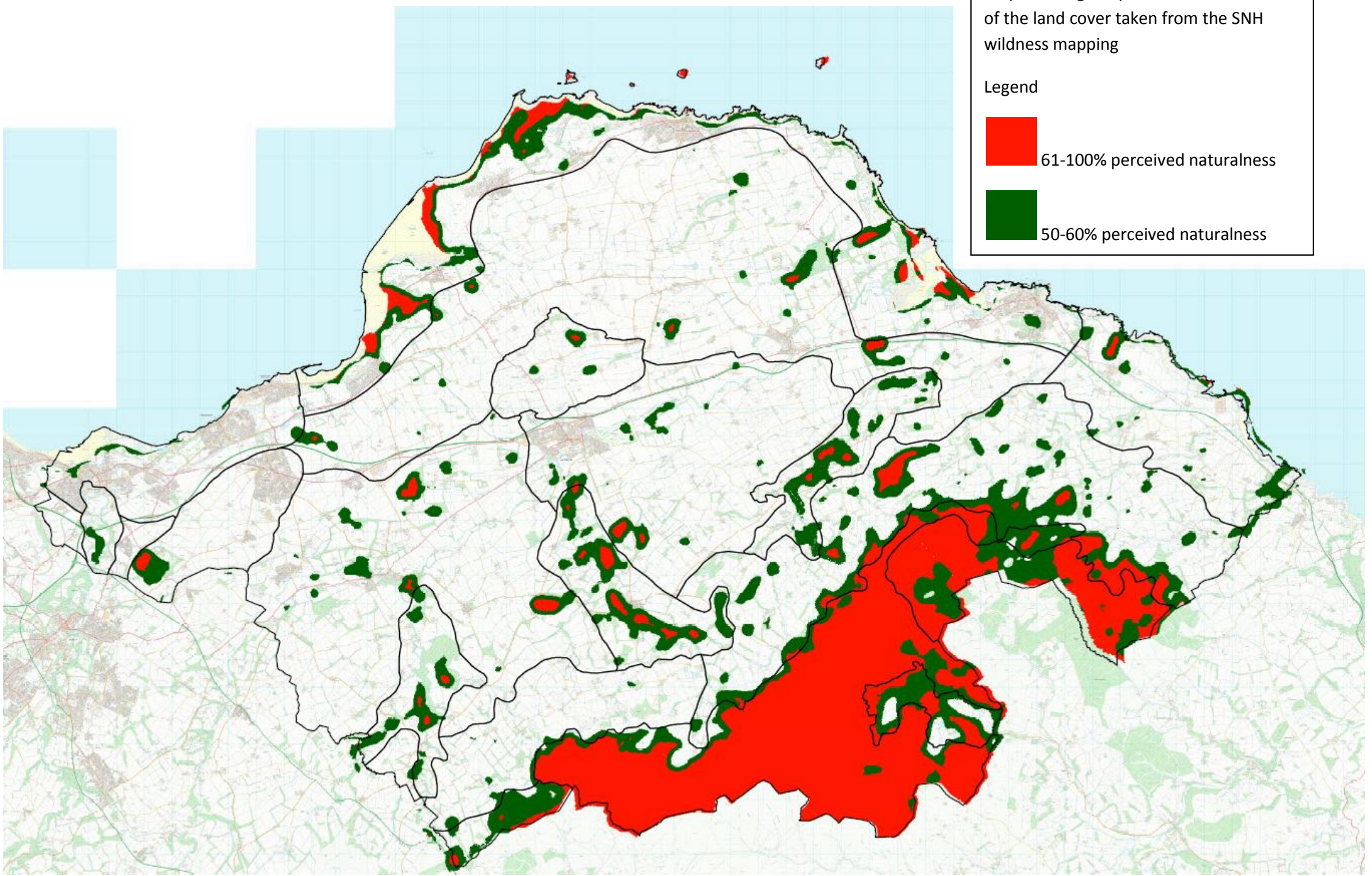

Map showing remoteness from public roads, ferries or railway stations taken from the SNH wilderness mapping

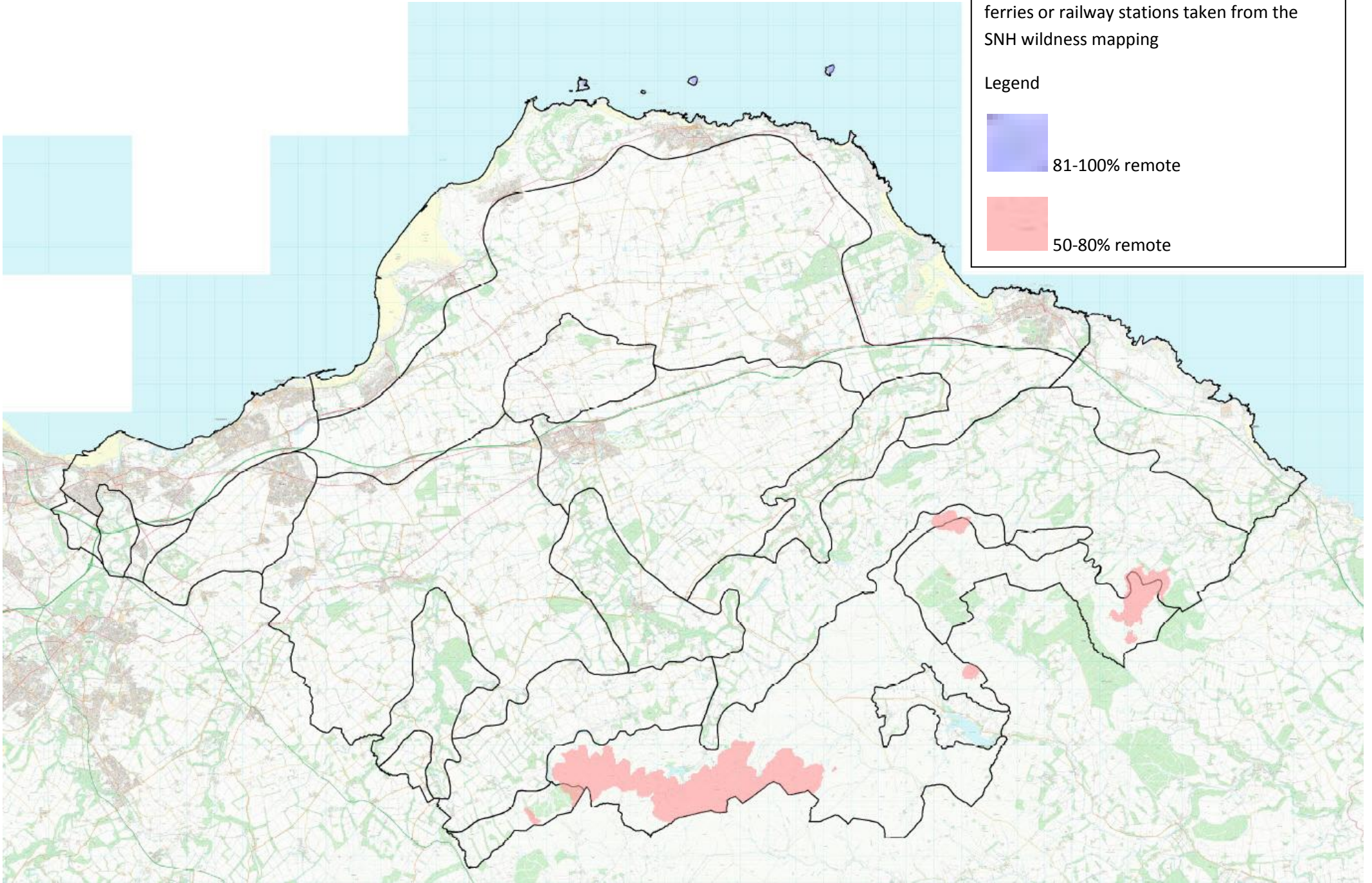

Map showing the visible lack of buildings, roads, pylons and other modern artefacts taken from SNH wilderness mapping

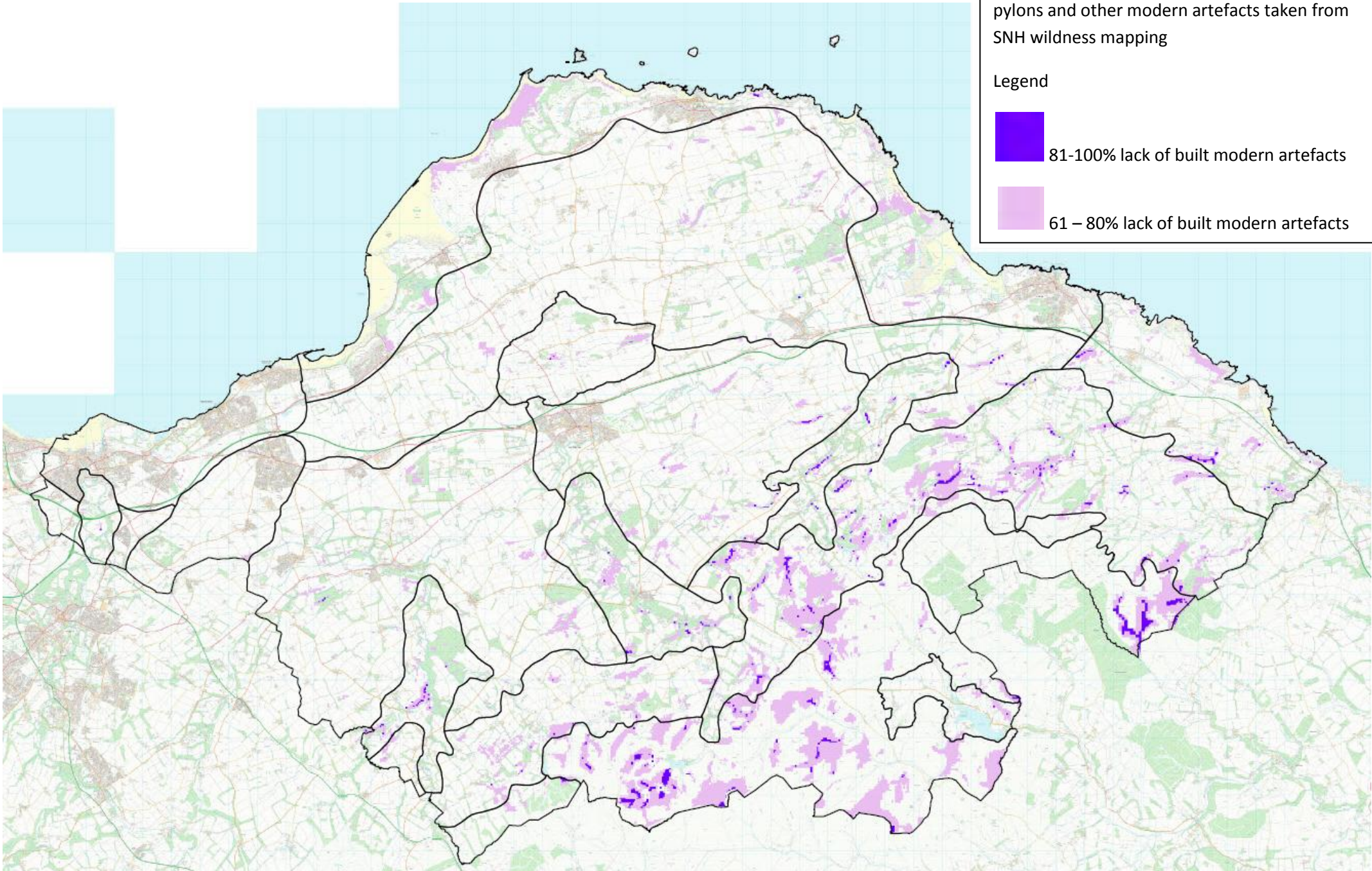

Map showing light pollution and darkness within East Lothian from Google Night-lights imagery by NASA's Earth Observatory overlaid with Landscape Character Area boundaries



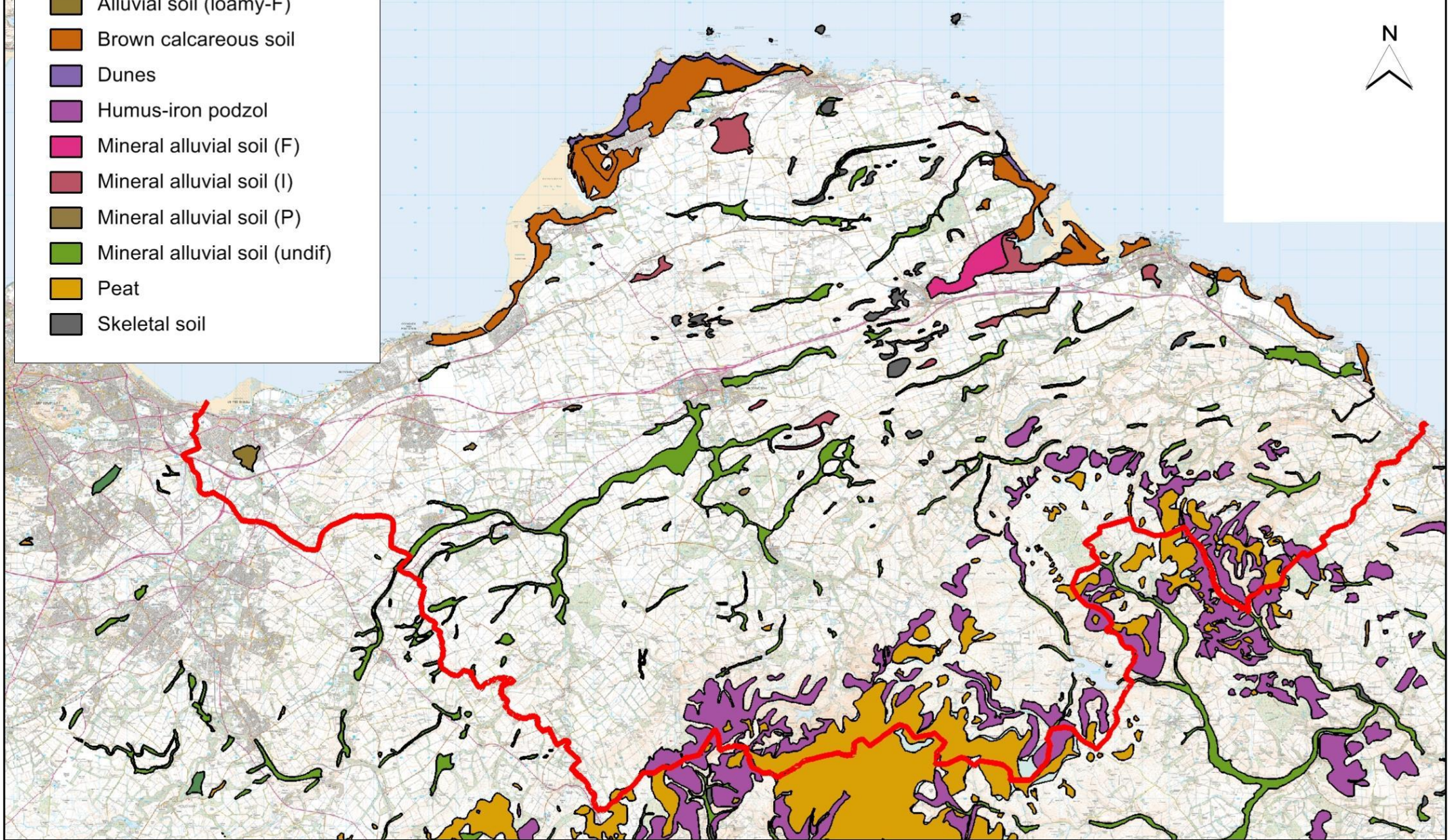

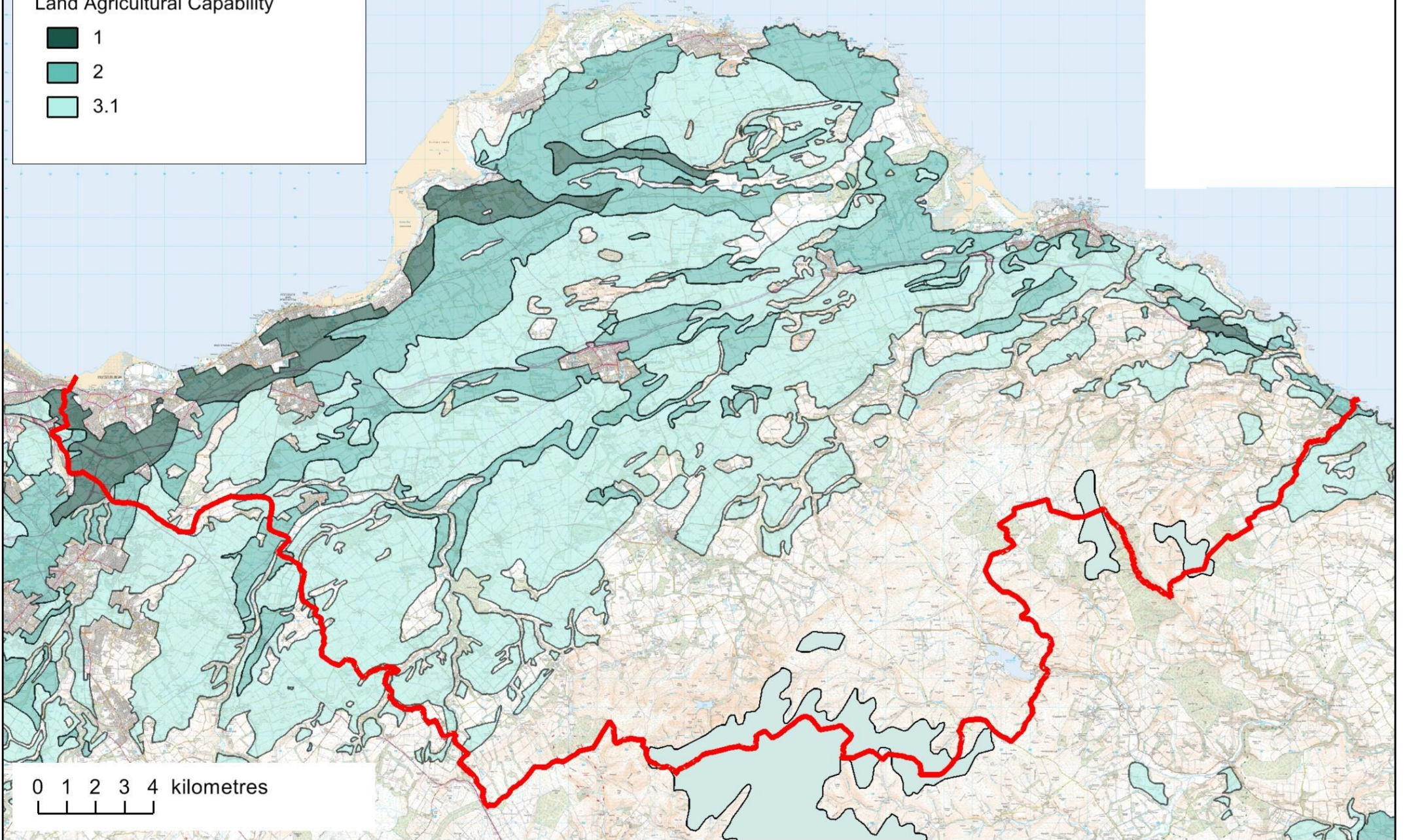
