### 3. APPLICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

#### 3a Application for Assistance – Our Lady of Loretto Youth Players

The Common Good Committee considered an application from David Ross on behalf of Our Lady of Loretto Youth Players for funds of £6,000 to help stage their annual musical theatre production in the Brunton Theatre.

#### Decision

The Common Good Committee unanimously agreed to grant the application in part in the sum of £2,500.

# **3b** Application for Assistance – Old Craighall Residents and Tenants Association

The Common Good Committee considered an application from Stuart Thomson on behalf of the Old Craighall Residents and Tenants Association for funds of £500 to purchase a self-propelled rugged petrol lawnmower and petrol hedge trimmer.

#### Decision
