1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to ask Elected Members to approve an increase in the S1 capping level at Dunbar Grammar School for school session 2017/18.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 Elected Members are asked to approve an increase in the S1 capping level at Dunbar Grammar School for session 2017/18 from 200 to 210 pupils.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 On 21 March 2017, the Education Committee agreed to a maximum intake level in S1 at Dunbar Grammar School of 200 pupils.
- 3.2 Since the Committee met, the number of expected S1 pupils has increased to 198 for the start of the school session in 2017/18. This leaves limited availability of places for pupils moving into catchment during the summer holiday period and throughout the 2017/18 school session.
- 3.3 The school is able to revise its timetable to accommodate 210 S1 pupils for session 2017/18 with no additional cost. As a result, this paper requests an increase in the S1 capping level from 200 to 210 pupils in line with the school timetable.
