Secondly, regarding the extending of the business to include off-sales, deliveries and take-aways, NHS Lothian would like to request that it is made a condition of the license that alcohol is sold for consumption off the premises only when accompanying an order for food. NHS Lothian is concerned about the rise in alcohol consumption from off-sales and East Lothian has already declared the whole of the area as overprovided.

LICENSING (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 - OBJECTION APPLICATION FOR THE VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE **POONTHAI'S** 7 WESTGATE, NORTH BERWICK, EAST LOTHIAN, EH39 4AE. POONSAP CUMPSTIE

I refer to the above application for the variation of a premises licence under terms of Section 29(5) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The variation requested consists of a request to increase on sales hours, add off sales, to change the terms under which children and young persons will be allow entry, to allow certain activities to take place out with core hours, during periods of extended hours and to add deliveries and takeaways as activities.

In terms of Section 22(1)(a) of the same Act, I make the following objection.

- Question 2 The request to increase the 'on sales' hours to include a terminal hour of midnight Monday to Wednesday is out with Board Policy and the police will not support this request.
- Question 3 In relation to the general increase in licensed hours and the request for 'off sales', is also out with Board Policy with regards to the overprovision statement and as such the applicant will be expected to demonstrate that the grant of these additional hours would outweigh the presumption against grant in terms of the overprovision statement.

• Question 6(b) - Children and Young Persons will be allowed access to the premises when accompanied by an Adult over 18.

Question 6(d) - No restriction on times.

The premises currently have the following wording: 'Children and Young Persons will be allowed access to the premises for the purposes of having a meal when accompanied by an Adult over 18.'

Until 8pm

I would request that the original wording "for the purposes of having a meal" is maintained, otherwise you are leaving the children and young person access open until the terminal hour (potentially midnight) whether the adult is having a meal or not.

 Question 5 - Certain Activities will take place out with core hours, during periods of extended hours.

The applicant has ticked 'yes' to this for 'outdoor drinking facilities'. The licence currently has a local condition for the outside area not to be used after 2230 hours. In the interest of the local residents, the police cannot support this request. 2230 hours is a generous time in comparison to other premises, any use of the outside area after that time has the potential to cause 'public nuisance'.

• Question 5(f) - To add Deliveries and Takeaways as Activities

Could the applicant please clarify what they mean by "Deliveries"? Is this deliveries of food or alcohol or both?

If it is deliveries of alcohol, the applicant should be fully aware of the requirements under Section 119 of the Act.

In terms of section 22(1)(a) of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, I am of the opinion that the variation should be refused on the grounds that it would be inconsistent with the licensing objectives of:

- preventing public nuisance
- protecting and improving public health
- Protecting children and young persons from harm

Any increase of hours and further access to alcohol via 'off sales' and 'deliveries' has an effect on public health. Increasing the duration that children and young persons are on licensed premises and potential access to alcohol through deliveries to private houses, increases the 'risk' to children and young persons. The use of the outside area after 2230 hours has in the past caused 'public nuisance' with local residents and has the potential to cause problems again, if allowed.

This objection is submitted for your attention in considering this application.

I make the following observations in relation to the changes applied for in this application:

- There is no objection to the change of the proposed opening times each day to 11.30 hours, which is within Board Policy.
- There is no objection to the proposed change to the terminal hour on Thursdays to Sundays, to 24:00, which is in line with Board policy.
- The proposed increase in the terminal hour on Monday to Wednesday to 24:00 is outwith Board Policy. To protect nearby residents from noise nuisance during the working week it is recommended that the current closing time of 23:00 be

continued.

- The addition of 'off-sales' facilities is supported for the purposes of persons, having partaken of a meal, being able to take away any unfinished bottle of wine or if alcohol is supplied along with a carryout order of a meal prior to 22.15.
- Access for children and young persons to the premises during operating hours is supported. To be consistent with other Board decisions, children should leave the premises prior to 22.00 unless attending a pre-arranged event when they may remain until the conclusion of that event.
- The proposed addition of deliveries and takeaways is supported provided that the delivery or takeaway comprises of alcohol included as ancillary to a meal and that delivery drivers comply with Challenge 25 procedures and the rules contained in Section 119 of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

For the information of the Board, Poonthai's is a very well-run popular restaurant premises. There have been no complaints regarding the operation of the Premises Licence since the review of the licence on 20/11/2009, which related to complaints of regular disturbance from the outside dining and drinking area to the rear of the premises.
