

### SUPPLEMETARY STATEMENT APPLICATION FOR PROVISIONAL PREMISE LICENCE WINTON BREWERY, 48 LIMEKILNS, PENCAITLAND, EH34 5HF

The following information outlines compliance with the licensing objectives set out in the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

- 1. Preventing crime and disorder
- 2. Securing Public Safety.

As this is an on-line delivery only service, there is no access to the property by members of the public. This means that the level of alcohol is controlled and therefore has no knock on effects for any crime and disorder on the premises, thus securing public safety.

### 3. Preventing Public Nuisance

Given the fact that the premises are an on-line Brewery and has no public access, there will be no groups of people accumulating outside so there will be a minimal risk of noise nuisance.

### 4. Protecting and Improving Public Health

The nature of the Brewery is such that it is for on-line sales only and does not have a bar. This is to provide a service to provide customers who can't access products that we sell, in their local shops and gives them the chance to purchase our products. The Brewery will sell through distributors and direct retail customers as our main sale route.

Online Sales will be controlled by the following:

- a) Purchasers will have to confirm that they are of the legal age to purchase alcohol.
- b) Purchasers will be advised that there are strict controls by the delivery carrier and production of I.D will be requested on delivery.

Given the nature and quality of the products, the company actively promotes responsible drinking. Consumers will be advised on our website to drink responsibly and to drink less but quality products.

### 5. Protecting Children from Harm

No Children are allowed in the distillery and strict controls are in place in relation to on-line sales.

Winton Brewery only engages a specialist drinks carrier

- a) To ensure the drinks are handled with care
- b) To ensure that employees are specially trained in ensuring no alcohol is delivered to persons under 18 years of age.
- c) Delivery personal will ask for ID for any persons thought to be under the age of 25. This will be in the form of a passport or driving licence (photographic evidence).
- d) Staff will be trained prior to being allowed to deliver alcohol. Challenge 25 is part of the training provided to staff. In the first instance delivery will be by the licence holders and designated premise manager of the firm.

I can confirm that the premises have been visited in relation to this application.

The applicant has been operating the sale and supply of alcohol from these premises since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 by way of Occasional Licences. To date, there have been no complaints received or any identified issues or problems surrounding the operation of the licences.

I would recommend that if the Board is minded to support this application that consideration be given to requiring the following conditions:

- The Internet sales system must verify by declaration that the purchaser is 18 years of age or over before accepting any order.
- The Licence Holder to ensure that delivery staff are trained to the standard prescribed in The Licensing (Training of Staff) Regulations 2007 and the requirements of The Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 Section 119 in respect of delivery of alcohol from vehicles.
- No alcohol to be left at any address where there is no person to receive it.

At present, there are two similar Premises Licences in place in respect of wine distributors that operate from residential properties in East Linton and North Berwick. They have not been the subject of complaint or operating problems.

This report is submitted for the information and consideration of Board members.
