
## **Appendix 1 – Summary Report on Rent Level Consultation 2019-20**


In November 2018, we wrote out to all our tenants and sent them a consultation questionnaire. This gave tenants the opportunity to let us know their views on the rent consultation and also the potential increase of 5%. Shown below is a summary of all the responses received.














In question 7 we gave tenants the opportunity to tell us what they would like us to do more of and what we can do better. Over 400 comments were received which consisted of general comments as well as suggestions about services. The top three areas which comments related to were repairs, modernisation and rent issues.
