Decision

The Common Good Committee agreed that further information was required before they could reach a decision on the application. The Committee requested that the following information be sought from the Dunbar Parents Group:

- · Copies of any minutes of meetings;
- Confirmation that a Group bank account had been set up and details of that account;
- Details of other organisations the Group had approached regarding their project, e.g. local schools, community council, and whether any approaches had been made to other funding sources since September 2018;
- If the application were only to be granted in part, information on how any sums would be used and the potential impact on the project as a whole.

The Committee agreed that once this information was received an additional meeting should be arranged.
