1. MINUTES FOR APPROVAL

3. FEEDBACK FROM ORGANISATIONS IN RECEIPT OF GRANT

There was no feedback from organisations in receipt of grant. The members discussed their concerns about the general lack of feedback and agreed that the requirement for feedback, and the use of the Common Good logo, should be made clear when funding is approved. The members also agreed that a list should be requested from Finance of those organisations who had received funding during the financial year ended 31 March 2018 indicating which, if any, that had provided feedback.

4. APPLICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION

4a. Application for Assistance – Musselburgh Grammar School

The Common Good Committee considered an application from Musselburgh Grammar School for the sum of £960 to install a mural at a site on Musselburgh High Street.

Decision

The Common Good Committee unanimously agreed to grant the application in full.

4b. Application for Assistance - Musselburgh Congregational Church

The Common Good Committee considered an application from Musselburgh Congregational Church for the sum of £4721 to replace secondary glazing and to repair all mastic surrounds and sill to outside of windows.

Councillor Forrest expressed concerns about the competence of the application and said that, in his view, it did not provide enough of a benefit to the wider community.
