Planning Application No. 18/01344/P: Erection of 4 houses, 22 flats and associated works at land west of Johnnie Cope's Road, Mid Road, Prestonpans (pages 113-127) Note - this application was called off the Scheme of Delegation List by Councillor Gilbert for the following reasons: Although the land is designated for business use part of the site has already been developed and the remaining land seems unlikely to be used for business purposes. Affordable rent would seem an obvious alternative.
