## 1. MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS OF 3 MARCH 2020

The minutes of the meetings of 3 March 2020 were approved.

#### 2. MATTERS ARISING

The Clerk noted that, as the Haddstock event had not taken place in May 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the funding had not been issued to that organisation.

#### 3a. APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE – HADDINGTON BOWLING CLUB

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Haddington Bowling Club for funding of £12,519.13 to install an accessible toilet facility and associated works.

#### Decision

The Common Good Committee agreed to grant the application in part to the sum of  $\pounds 2,000$ , noting that they would welcome a further application in the 2021/2 financial

year for additional funding for the project once the Bowling Club's application for Community Intervention Funding had been determined.

#### 3b. APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE – HADDINGTON COMMUNITY COUNCIL

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Haddington Community Council (Tourism Development Group) for funding of £3,075 to carry out a scoping study to examine potential tourism developments for Haddington.

**Declaration of Interest**: Councillor Hoy declared an interest on the basis of his involvement with the Tourism Development Group, and left the meeting for the duration of this item.

#### Decision

The Common Good Committee agreed to support the application in principle, granting the application in part to the sum of  $\pounds$ 3,000, with the funding to be issued on the submission of a satisfactory scoping report.
