# 1. MINUTE OF THE MEETING OF 30 MARCH 2021

# 2A. APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE – BLOOMING HADDINGTON

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Blooming Haddington for funding of £1,682 to ensure the town centre had enough hanging baskets to look its best for the upcoming Keep Scotland Beautiful 2021 competition.

The Common Good Committee agreed to continue the application for further information.

### 2B. APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE - HADDINGTON BOWLING CLUB

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Haddington Bowling Club for funding of £9,919.13 to install an accessible toilet facility for wheelchair users and people with life-long conditions making the Club completely accessible to all.

## 2C. APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE - HADDINGTON GARDEN TRUST

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Haddington Garden Trust for funding of £7,000 to cover maintenance costs.

Councillor McMillan declared an interest in this item as the Council's elected member representative on the Haddington Garden Trust. He could not therefore take part in discussion on this application.

#### Decision

## 2D. APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY HADDINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL

The Common Good Committee considered an application by Haddington Primary School for funding of £1,656 to purchase a Frame Running Bike for use by children who have a lower limb disability or balance/co-ordination difficulties.
