SUBJECT:	Membership of the East Lothian Integration Joint Board

1 PURPOSE

1.1 To seek the Integration Joint Board's (IJB) approval for the appointment of a new non-voting member.

2 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

2.1 The IJB is asked to approve the appointment of Dr Wendy Hale as a non-voting member, specialising in substance abuse, for the maximum term of office of 3 years.

3 BACKGROUND

3.1 The Public Bodies (Joint Working) (Integration Joint Boards) (Scotland) Order 2014 (SSI 2014 No.285) allows each IJB to appoint additional nonvoting members as it considers appropriate. Following discussions involving the Chief Officer, Chair and Dr Jon Turvill, it is proposed to create a new non-voting member role specialising in substance abuse. Dr Wendy Hale is a Consultant Psychiatrist for the Addictions Service in East Lothian. It is proposed that Dr Hale be appointed to this new role for the maximum term of office of 3 years.
