### 1 PURPOSE

1.1 To outline to elected members sponsorship support for the staging of the 2022 Genesis Scottish Open (7<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> July) and AIG Women's Open (4<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> August)

### 2 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

2.1 To note the planning arrangements for both events and the financial support agreed.

### 3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The ASI Scottish Open was been held at The Renaissance in 2018, 2019 and 2020 and has become a recognised event in East Lothian's events calendar. In 2020, the event was held behind closed doors without spectators. Previous events have showed a local net economic impact of around £5m with approximately 68,000 attending. The event returns to the Renaissance Club for 2022 from 7<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> July with a new sponsor and will be branded the Genesis Scottish Open.
- 3.2 For the first time in its history, The Honourable Company of Edinburgh Golfers will host the 2022 AIG Women's Open from 4<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> August. Hosting the event marks a significant step for the venue to be considered for the men's Open Championship.
- 3.3 Event arrangements for both events will be discussed and agreed at East Lothian Safety Advisory Group meetings.
- 3.4 East Lothian Council has agreed sponsorship levels for both tournaments.
- 3.5 The European Tour will provide the following partner rights to East Lothian Council for the Genesis Scottish Open:
  - Digital Visit East Lothian advert to include the golf offer

- Feature in the digital programme highlighting golf and the wider East Lothian destination
- Feature in newsletter to ticket holders matching the programme messaging and encouraging stay and spend
- Acknowledgement as a sponsor via logo on the event website and app
- Acknowledgement as a sponsor via logo on the partners recognition board(s) at the tournament and in the digital programme
- 10 one day tickets (these will be offered as competition prizes)
- Access to Getty photography captured at the tournament
- 3.6 The R&A will provide the following advertising, promotional and branding rights to East Lothian Council as an 'Official Supplier' of the AIG Women's Open:

# Advertising and Promotions

- 3x on course advertising banners in televised positions (logo will be white out of blue and agreed production costs will be met by The R&A)
- 2x off course advertising banners
- Partner logo placement on the Website
- Partner logo placement and 1x advert in the Official Event Programme
- Partner logo placement in the daily draw sheet
- Partner logo placement on the sponsor board
- 6x 30 second onscreen adverts per Championship day at the Venue to highlight East Lothian as a golfing destination
- Vignettes of East Lothian in live television broadcasts

Access to:

- up to 5 minutes of video archive footage from The R&A video archive;
- up to 5 still images from The R&A image collection, subject to The R&A's prior written approval of the use of such footage and images.

- 2x tickets for official Event functions

## R&A Women in Golf

Invitations to participate in R&A Women in Golf initiatives relating to the AIG Women's Open.

3.7 Branding across both tournaments will be Visit East Lothian Scotland's Golf Coast.
